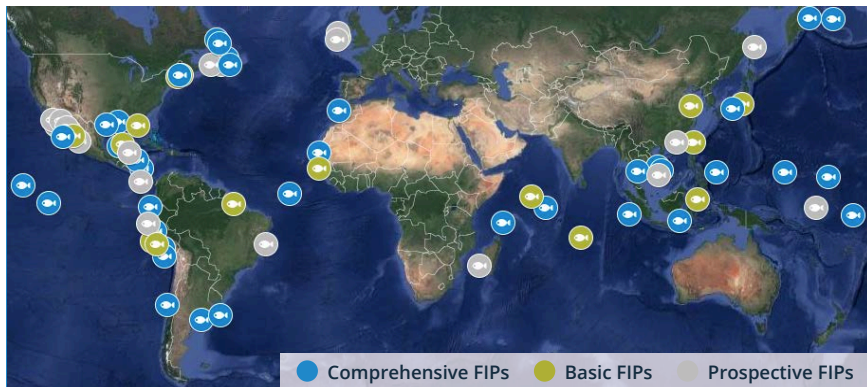


**FISHERYPROGRESS.ORG** is the one-stop shop for reliable information about fishery improvement project progress.

FisheryProgress makes verified FIP progress information accessible and reliable for hundreds of industry and NGO users.

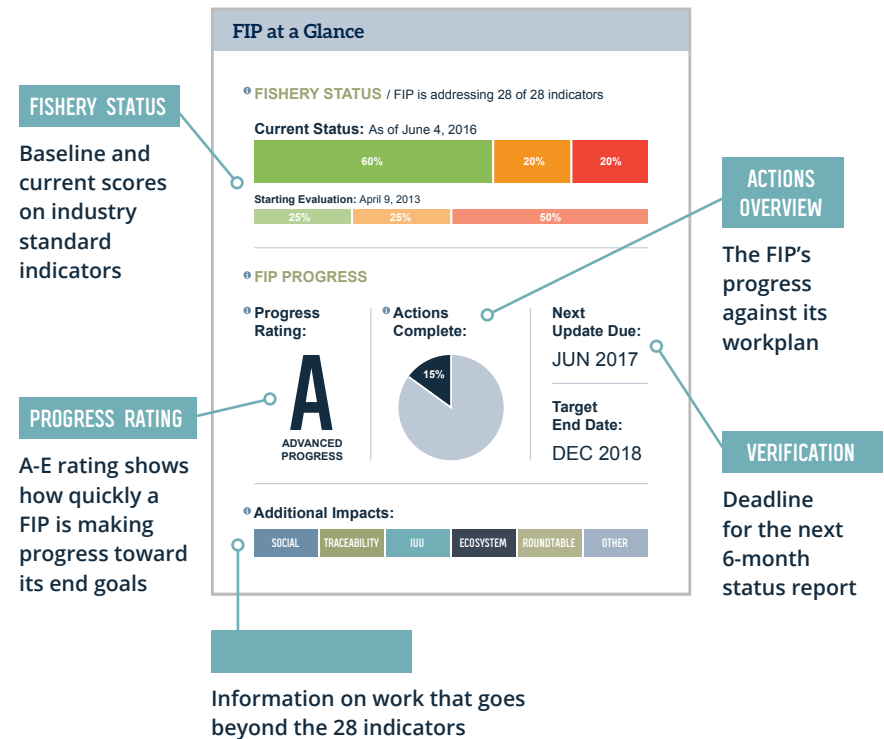
